Dr. Ney, the first Doctor of Social Media in the UK, is passionate about all things social and digital. She established Disruptive Insight, Scotland's first social intelligence consultancy. There, she refined products such as opinion tracking and perception mapping, and provided insights to 'nudge' desirable behaviors.

She has worked with major brands in the UK including British Airways, The O2, Tennent's Lager, Scottish Enterprise, Event Scotland and Glasgow 2014. IBM invited Jillian onto the Global Entrepreneurship Programme, and she sat at a roundtable with key industry figures to develop a whitepaper on the influence of social media on business.

As well as many research publications and conference presentations, Jillian delivered two TED Talks: Connectedness and the Digital Self, and Pushing Boundaries: The AI Future of Marketing. In 2017, her book, Social Intelligence for Marketing Campaigns, is scheduled for publication by Business Expert Press.

She developed a module in digital marketing and social media, and was nominated for the most innovative and enthusiastic lecturer in the Teaching Excellence Awards 2013 and 2014.

Jillian uses her skills and talents to help others achieve, be they business people, politicians or students. She does so by analysing Big Data to create insights and social intelligence tools that drive marketing success, improve business performance and help create the conditions in which people thrive.
